GAUGE

Worked on Size US #13 (9mm) Needles

2.5 st & 3 rows per inch

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Laying flat. Unblocked.

3.5" Wide X 10" Long

SUPPLIES

Size US #13 (9mm) Needles
Approx. 40 yards of Super Bulky weight yarn
(Shown in Lion Brand Thick & Quick in "Caviar")
Cable Needle
Waste Yarn for Provisional CO
Size 10mm Crochet Hook
Large Eye Tapestry Needle
Scissors

STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

co - cast on
rs - right side
sl - slip
st - stitch/es
wyib - with yarn in back
k - knit
p - purl
wyif - with yarn in front
rep - repeat
4-st LC - 4 stitch left crossing cable
" - inch/es

EXPLANATION OF STITCHES

4-stitch LC
(4 stitch Left Cable)

Slip 2 stitches onto cable needle (hold to front),
K2, K2 from cable needle.

PATTERN

Provisionally CO 14. (See video link on pg. 2)

Row 1: (RS) Sl first st knitwise wyib, K2, P2, K4, P2, K3.

Row 2: Sl first st purlwise wyif, P2, K2, P4, K2, P3.

Row 3: Rep. row 1.

Row 4: Rep. row 2.

Row 5: Sl first st knitwise wyib, K2, P2, 4-st LC, P2, K3.

Row 6: Rep. row 2.

Work rows 1-6 until length measures 4" less than head circumference.
(Example: For a 23" head, knit until piece measures 19".)

Undo provisional cast on, place the 14 live stitches onto second needle.
Using Kitchener Stitch, seam the headband. (See video link on pg. 2)

Weave in all ends and block if desired.



CHART & KEY

Note: Work odd # rows (right side of work) from right to left.
Even # rows (wrong side of work) from left to right.
